Position Overview

Emmanuel Barrie is seeking a Director of Life Groups to provide leadership, oversight, and spiritual direction for our Life Groups and Women's Ministry. This role is central to helping people grow in faith, connect in meaningful community, and live out authentic discipleship in smaller, relational settings.

This position is currently structured as a part-time role (approximately 24 hours per week), with the possibility of expanding to full-time depending on the passion, gifting, and demonstrated effectiveness of the successful applicant.

Key Responsibilities

- Provide vision, leadership, and oversight for Life Groups and Women's Bible Studies. This role will include providing leadership to a newly re-started Women's ministry as well.
- Recruit, train, coach, and support group leaders and facilitators
- Develop and manage group rhythms, launches, and ongoing coordination
- Select and oversee biblically faithful curriculum and resources
- Foster healthy group culture, spiritual growth, and care
- Collaborate with staff to help people connect from weekend services into groups
- Participate in staff meetings and contribute to the broader ministry team
